THE 16TH WARSAW JEWISH FILM FESTIVAL WILL TAKE PLACE NOVEMBER 12-18, 2018

at the POLIN Museum of the History of Polish Jews, and will encompass numerous panel debates and screenings. It's organizers strive to respond to the challenges of today and to present Jewish life in all its complexity. The 16th Warsaw Jewish Film Festival competition films will be vying for the festival CAMERA OF DAVID Awards in 12 categories, i.e. Best Feature Film, Best Documentary, Best Short.

The previous editions of the festival featured such films as, *Ida* (Academy Award for Best Foreign Language Film, 2015), *The Gatekeepers* (Israeli Film Academy Award for Best Documentary, 2013), *Lebanon* (Golden Lion, Venice International Film Festival, 2009), *West Bank Story* (Academy Award for Best Live Action Short Film, 2007), as well as *Beaufort* (Silver Bear, Berlin International Film Festival, 2007).

HISTORY AND MISSION

Established in 2003, the Warsaw Jewish Film Festival has been the first event of its kind in Poland. The aim of its organizers (The Camera of David WJFF Foundation) has been to create a space for the presentation of contemporary Jewish-themed movies, which have not been shown in Poland before. During the previous editions of the festival, we had a pleasure to present over 600 films from 30 countries. Apart from acclaimed movies and renowned filmmakers retrospectives, the festival line-up features directorial debuts, the organizers of the festival strive to present Jewish-themed cinema to Polish audiences by putting special emphasis on its intricacy and diversity.

EDUCATION

During a series of educational screenings following the festival in Warsaw, our foundation presents films, about the Holocaust that, promote tolerance, counter anti-Semitism and hate-speech. The screenings are held under the patronage of the main partner of the festival—the POLIN Museum and are organized together with a range of partners from all over

Poland, such as: Jewish Culture Festival in Cracow and the Galicia Jewish Museum, the Edelman Dialogue Center in Lodz, Auschwitz Jewish Center, the Poland-Israel Center for Citizenship Education in Bialystok, and JCC Warsaw or abroad such as: Los Angeles Jewish Film Festival and Jerusalem Film Festival.



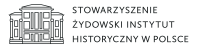
